



GADOVA PUSTOLOVKA COMPETITION RULES

All competitors compete at their own risk.

Persons under the age of 18 can only take part in the competition in a team with a parent.

All competitors must pick up the starting package before the race and place the markings provided by the organizer on the equipment. Markings must be placed on visible place until the end of the race.

Competitors must take care of their own food and drink during the race. The organizer will organize several locations with refreshments.

Competitors may not use any means of transport other than those allowed by the organizer.

Competitors must comply with traffic regulations.

Competitors must wear the following mandatory equipment throughout the competition:

- Team mandatory equipment: first aid, compass.
- Individual mandatory equipment: Helmet, whistle, astro-foil, head lamp.

Competitors compete in pairs, except for the tourist category.

The maximum allowed distance between team members is 30m but both team members must visit all checkpoints. On some checkpoints you will receive additional instructions and this rule does not apply.

The final ranking will be determined based on the time of arrival at the finish line, penalties and points collected. The organizer will inform the competitors before the race about the method of collecting points.

Any violation of traffic regulations, failure to carry equipment, excessive distance of team members or any violation of other rules will be penalized at the end of the competition. Organizer will define penalties before the start of the race.

Competitors are not allowed to litter! Do not throw garbage in the nature!

If any of the organizers or any official considers that a competitor is injured, exhausted, has damaged equipment or is unable to continue the race for other reasons, he will be excluded from the competition.



Competitors are responsible for the equipment provided to them by the organizer and must compensate the damage they have caused.

The organizer is not responsible for the equipment of competitors who damage or lose it themselves.

By registering, the contestants agree that the organizer takes film and photographic material from the competition and uses it in the media and for promotional purposes.

By registering for the competition, each member of the team confirms that he is familiar with the complexity of the course and the competition rules. The organizer warns that there is no signal for mobile telephone on the part of the route.

The organizer reserves the right to interpret the competition rules and also change them – in that case he will inform the competitors before the race.
